

MINNESOTA'S NEW MULTI-PURPOSE STADIUM CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Dear Neighbor,

As you know, the Minnesota Sports Facilities Authority (MSFA) in partnership with the Minnesota Vikings is building a new, multi-purpose stadium on the site of the Metrodome. The MSFA approved the Construction Management Plan allowing Mortenson/Thor to move ahead with construction of the Minnesota Multi-purpose Stadium. Below is a timeline of current and upcoming activities:


- Excavation: December 2013 - April 2014
- Demolition: January 2014 - April 2014

Excavation of the Metrodome parking lot began last week and is progressing at a good pace. The excavation will continue Sunday through Friday from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm to 6:00 am through April 2014.

In addition, construction crews will begin driving piles on Wednesday, December 11th. This work utilizes a diesel hammer to pound cylinder-shaped pieces of steel into the ground at multiple locations. The work will continue intermittently through December 31st between the hours of 7:00 am and 6:00 pm. During these times, you can expect an continuous pounding to occur, which is normal with this type of work.

We look forward to continuing to update the neighborhood on the construction of Minnesota's New Multi-Purpose Stadium on a regular basis. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me directly.
