

# MINNESOTA MULTI-PURPOSE STADIUM CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

FEBRUARY 21, 2014

Dear Neighbor,

The Minnesota Sports Facilities Authority (MSFA) in partnership with the Minnesota Vikings is building a new multi-purpose stadium on the site of the Metrodome. Mortenson/Thor is overseeing construction and is providing neighborhood construction updates on a regular basis.

As you may be aware, a portion of the ringbeam on the Metrodome fell out of sequence earlier this week. After consulting with structural and demolition experts, it has been determined that the safest way to bring down the remaining portion of the ringbeam is with controlled explosive charges. We wish to inform you that this controlled demolition of the remaining ringbeam will occur at approximately 7:30 a.m. on Sunday, February 23rd.

This date and time was chosen in consideration of the low volume of vehicular and pedestrian traffic in the area, and to accommodate our immediate neighbors by providing the greatest buffer possible between our brief street closures and their earliest scheduled activities.

For safety reasons, there will be temporary street and sidewalk closures from 5:30 a.m. until approximately 9:00 a.m. on Sunday. Please note that no public access will be permitted within 250' of the Metrodome during this time. Minneapolis Police will be securing this perimeter. The Metrodome LRT station will be closed during this timeframe as well. MTC buses will serve as alternate transportation and will shuttle passengers between stations adjacent to the Metrodome. Attached is a map outlining the road closures and detours.

You will hear a loud noise when the charges are detonated and when the ringbeam falls to the ground. The actual demolition process will take approximately 10 seconds. We anticipate there will be perceptible vibrations due to the blast and ensuing collapse. You may feel vibration in the area for approximately 5 seconds. It is inevitable that dust will also be generated during this process. The current weather conditions will play a significant role in dust suppression and it is not anticipated that significant amounts of dust will migrate beyond the site limits.

As always, the safety of our workers, the general public and the surrounding neighborhoods are our highest priorities. Thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation.

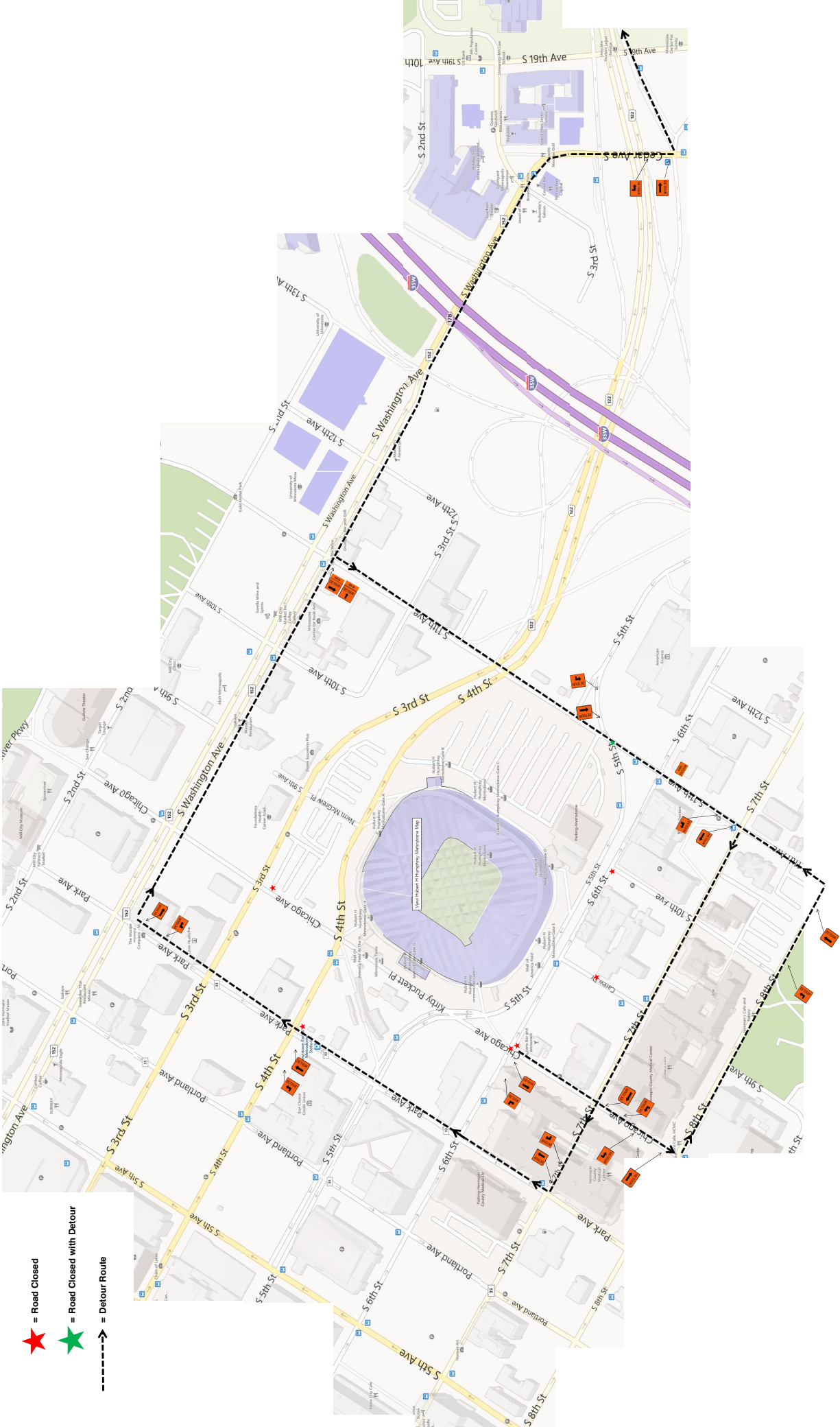
We will continue to update the neighborhood on the construction of the Minnesota Multipurpose Stadium. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me directly.
