Historical Background Zoning Code Text Amendment – Amending regulations for off premises signs and billboards

<u>June 17, 2016 – Regular City Council Meeting – CM Warsame announces intent to present at the July 1, 2016, City Council Meeting.</u>

July 1, 2016 – Regular City Council Meeting – CM Warsame introduces his proposal for amending the regulations for off premises signs and billboards. Council refers to the proposal to the Zoning and Planning Committee.

<u>July 20, 2016 – Zoning and Planning Committee reviews CM Warsame's proposal.</u> They do not take any action, but refer the item to staff.

<u>August 17, 2017 – City Planning Commission, Committee of the Whole – City staff member Steve Poor reintroduces the proposal.</u>

September 18, 2017 – City Planning Commission – City staff member presents the proposal. Staff recommends approval.

Action: The City Planning Commission recommended that the City Council **approve** the text amendment to enlarge the Downtown Entertainment Billboard District and remove the restrictions of City financing of billboards, striking proposed changes to section 544.90.

The City Planning Commission further recommended that the City Council **return** amendments to Chapter 525 to the author.

December 4, 2017 – City Planning Commission – City staff presents the update proposal. Staff recommends approval.

Action: This item was continued to the January 8, 2018 Planning Commission meeting.
