
Project Goals

- Support active transportation options






11th Ave S: Project Revisions W River Pkwy to Washington Ave S

Design Goals:

- Establish predictable behaviors for all modes of travel
- Encourage slower turning speeds and travel at posted speed limit
- Support non-motorized safety and mobility
- Test new and innovative design

2nd St S Project Summary 10th Ave S/Gold Medal Park Intersection

Project Goals

Improve safety at crossing for all people, regardless of mode of travel

Increase visibility and sightlines at intersections

Identify traffic calming and appropriate safety treatment

- Provide refuge area to reduce exposure
- Encourage travel at or below posted speed
