Dear Michele:

I am writing to you on behalf of the Downtown Minneapolis Neighborhood Association regarding the Class A liquor license application for Bus Stop Brewhouse. Owner Brian Ingram presented the application to the DMNA Land Use Committee on November 4, 2018.

Owner Ingram provided some background on his experience in the restaurant business. He highlighted a number of other restaurants that he owns in the metro area, including New Bohemia and the 7<sup>th</sup> Street Truck Park. He went on to describe the theme of this new restaurant, which is to celebrate the golden age of bus travel. He noted that the exterior façade will feature a non-operable bus. The menu will include craft blended burgers, chicken, as well as vegan foods. They will purchase meet and baked goods from local suppliers. Ingram also noted the hours will be from 11 a.m. to midnight during the week and 11 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on the weekends. He concluded by describing the exterior public realm. He said that it will be similar to McKinney Roe and will complement the feel of the surrounding neighborhood.

After some questions and discussion, the Land Use Committee recommended approval of the Class A liquor license application for Bus Stop Brewhouse. The DMNA Board reviewed and supported the recommendation at its meeting on November 19.
