Please describe your experience with nonprofit organizations and/or boards, plus list any previous experience volunteering with the DMNA.

DMNA:
I have been a board member of the DMNA since 2015 and I was Chair for 3 years from 2016 - 2019. I have accomplished the following while in the DMNA - (1) Established the first Police Substation (MPD), which now houses MPD's "Homeless Initiative" police. I donated in excess of 100 hours over 3 years and personally paid for many expenses related to establishing the substation. I'm very proud that it finally opened in March of this year. (2) I've organized and conducted two very large (in excess of 90 people) community meetings in 2017 on the issue of 205 Park Ave construction. (3) I've organized and conducted two large meetings on public safety, wherein I was able to have representatives of MPD, City Attorney's Office, MPRB Police, social service agencies, and community organizers attend. (4) I've organized and participated in numerous "Washington Ave Clean-Up" activities. (5) I've organized and conducted 3 annual DMNA meetings. (6) I've organized and conducted several National Night Out events in downtown.

Henn. Ave. Safety Committee:

I've been a member since 2017, meeting at least once a month and participating in events.

Henn. Ave. Stakeholders' Committee:

This committee was exclusively concerned with the reconstruction of Henn. Ave. during the years 2017 - 2019. I was the downtown residents' representative. We met at least once a month and decided on important issues on the streetscape of Henn. Ave.

Italian Cultural Center of Minneapolis/St. Paul (located in downtown):

I've been a member since 2012 and Vice Pres. since 2018. We provide language classes for adults and children and we host many community events throughout the year including - wine tasting, culinary and wine events, fine arts events, and the IFF (Italian Film Festival).
